Time Commitment

Programs range from one-hour sessions to year-long programs. Many partners opt for eight-week programs that meet for two hours each week, focusing on a single topic. We also offer stand-alone workshops and extended programs that incorporate multiple courses and topics.

Courses are typically scheduled Monday-Friday between 9 a.m. and 9 p.m. Weekend sessions may be available at an additional cost.

All offerings are subject to instructor availability. Providing advance notice increases the likelihood that we can accommodate your scheduling needs.

Format

Most classes are held in person at the employer's or partner's site. With advance planning, sessions can also take place at one of the University of Cincinnati's Victory campuses. Live online classes are available if all participants have a computer, webcam, internet access, and a distraction-free learning environment.

Assessment

Assessment is integral to quality instruction, and learning checks are incorporated throughout our programs. We can also develop custom assessments to measure participants' learning outcomes based on identified goals. Options include tailored assessments, projects, and presentations that allow participants to demonstrate their skills.

For standardized evaluation, we offer pre- and post-assessments using the TABE 13/14 and CLAS-E.

Cost

- Curriculum development
- Topic area
- Number of instructors
- Staff and administrative support
- Instructional materials (e.g., exam vouchers, curriculum licenses)
- Program format and duration
